

ACADEMIC POSITION IN PALLIATIVE ONCOLOGY

The Division of Hematology/Oncology in the Department of Medicine and the Cancer Therapy & Research Center (CTRC) at UT Health San Antonio MD Anderson Cancer Center is recruiting for an individual with a focus on cancer-specific palliative care. This individual will hold an academic appointment in the Department of Medicine. She/he will report to the Chief of Hematology/Oncology and be expected to have clinical, teaching and research responsibilities in the CTRC, an NCI-Designated Cancer Center. The individual will be expected to focus on enhancing palliative care programs. Individuals with a track record of participating in or leading palliative care teams in oncology, and with clinical trial experience are encouraged to apply. There will be ample opportunities for participation in multidisciplinary palliative care and research. Candidates should hold an M.D. and be board certified/eligible in Medical Oncology, and Hospice & Palliative Medicine, and be eligible for licensure by the Texas Medical Board.
