Clinics

- ❖ Weekly HIV Continuity and Infectious Diseases Clinics
- ❖ First year: VA, Second Year: UHS
- ❖ Both VA and UHS HIV clinics are set up as patient-centered medical homes, to provide HIV care, primary care, and mental health and social services to HIV patients under one roof.
- ❖ Hepatitis-C Clinic
- ❖ Transplant Clinic

Rotations

- ❖ Infectious Diseases consult service (usually 2 fellows, 80 consults per month)-consults on cases at both University and VA Hospitals
- ❖ Texas Center for Infectious Diseases (TCID) TCID is a public health facility for the treatment of Tuberculosis. TCID's Outpatient Clinic also serves as one of the state's Hansen Disease Clinics. TCID is organized to provide patient care, scientific investigation, therapeutic and educational services supporting public health needs.
