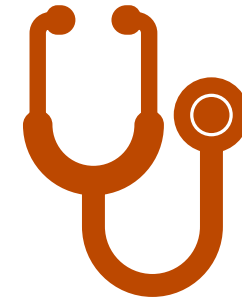

Allows students to demonstrate dedication to research



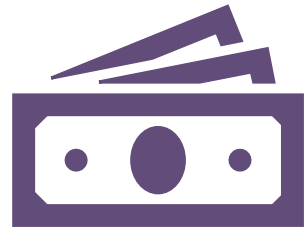
Medical Student Research Elective*

Ongoing initiatives to connect students with mentors

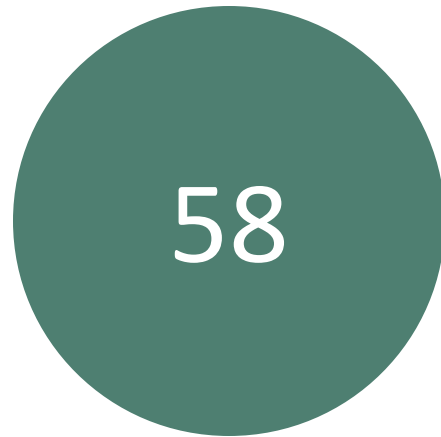


Funding a Project

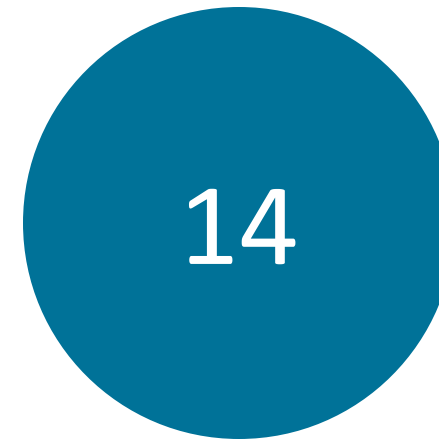

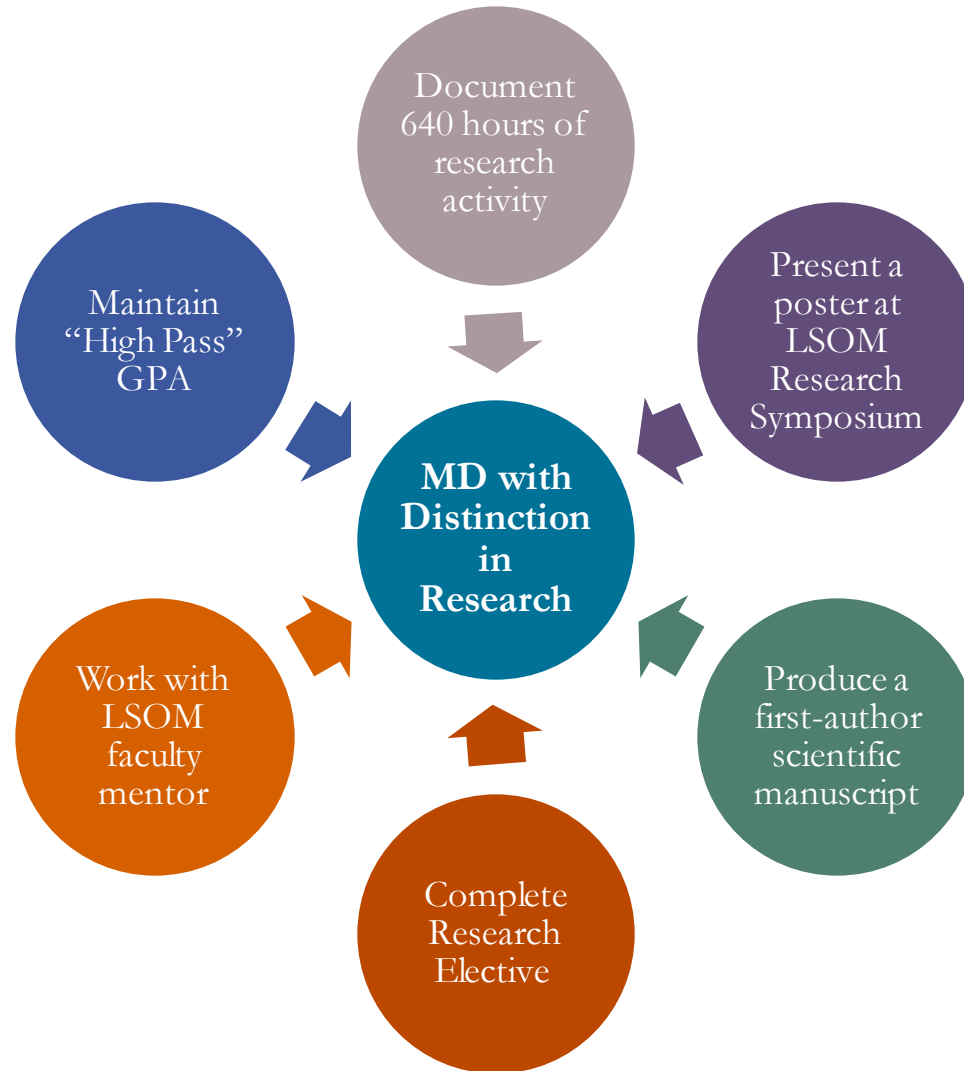

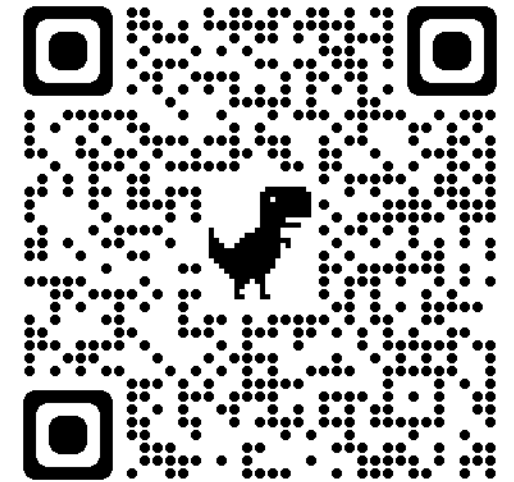
