Medical Student Research Liaison Program Expectations

The Medical Student Research Liaisons serve as the bridge between medical students and the LSOM Office for Research. They help facilitate medical student research by providing insight and feedback to the Office for Research, promoting and communicating Office for Research events, messaging, and resources, and leading the Medical Student Research Interest Group meetings.

- 1. Respond to any Office for Research email within 5 business days
- 2. Promote the Office for Research website, resources, events, and messaging
- 3. Answer medical student questions regarding Office for Research website, resources, and events
- 4. Attend or present research at the annual Research Symposium
- 5. Attend the Medical Student Council Meetings once a month and promote services offered via the Office for Research
- 6. Attend 4 research liaisons meetings per year with the Office for Research
- 7. Attend the monthly Medical Student Research Interest Group meetings
- 8. Initiate, plan, and execute 1 quality or process improvement project for the Office for Research

There are many benefits of being a Medical Student Research Liaisons, including:

- Networking with Office for Research Deans
- Develop leadership skills
- Assist peers and serve as a resource
- Academic credit for completing quality or process improvement projects
