Grant Development Program

The grant development program is designed to enhance the grantsmanship skills of early and mid-career clinical faculty with limited experience submitting grants and tenure-track basic science faculty pursuing basic science proposals. The workshop has a hybrid design to facilitate involvement with clinical and basic science colleagues. Participants will partake in didactic lectures detailing grant components and favorable writing styles. Each participant will submit subsection drafts (i.e., specific aims page, technical methods, and significance) throughout the course for personalized feedback via a recorded virtual review. Upon program completion, each participant is expected to have a proposal suitable for submission to an extramural funding agency.
