Ped-1 = Pediatric Urology - Basic (PGY-2)

Endo-1 = Endourology and Stone Disease (PGY-2)

Vdys = Voiding dysfunction (PGY-2)

Endo-2 = Advanced Endourology (PGY-3)

Onc-1 = Introduction to Urologic Oncology (PGY-3)

Urol-3 = General Urology - Men's Health Focus (PGY-3)

SubQI-1 = Vacation, Leave coverage all PGY-2, PGY-3; QI projects (PGY-3)

Ped-2 = Advanced Pediatric Urology (PGY-4)

Chief-UH = Chief at University Hospital - General & Oncology Focus (PGY-5)

Chief-VA = Chief at VA Hospital - General & Oncology Focus (PGY-5)

Chief-SR = Chief at Santa Rosa - Oncology Focus (PGY-5)

Admin - Administrative chief - Education Focus, Teaching Resident for cases at all sites, finish QI projects (PGY-5)
