Dr. Steven J. Hudak, M.D.
Associate Professor of Urology

Born and raised in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, Dr. Hudak graduated with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Biology from Luther College in Decorah, Iowa before obtaining his M.D. degree from the University of Iowa Carver College of Medicine in Iowa City, Iowa. He completed Urology residency training at the San Antonio Uniformed Services Health Education Consortium followed by a fellowship in Urologic Trauma, Reconstruction, and Prosthetics at UT Southwestern Medical Center in Dallas, Texas. He subsequently returned to San Antonio, where he built a clinical and research practice focused on the comprehensive care of military and civilian patients who sustained genitourinary injuries in the South Texas Region, across the country, and around the world. He received numerous military awards and decorations and in 2019 completed a 15-year active-duty career, ultimately achieving the rank of Lieutenant Colonel.

Most recently, Dr. Hudak returned to Dallas and joined the Urology faculty at UT Southwestern Medical Center where he is currently an Associate Professor of Urology, focusing his clinical work and research endeavors on urologic trauma, prosthetics, and reconstructive surgery. He has served as the Associate Program Director of the urology residency program since 2020 and will assume the role of Program Director later in 2021. He is a current member of the board of directors for the Society of Genitourinary Reconstructive Surgeons and has served on multiple organizations within the American Urological Association, including the AUA Young Urologists Committee (past chair), the AUA Public Policy Council, the AUA Urotrauma Clinical Guidelines Panel, the AUA Urotrauma Legislative Task Force, and the AUA Core Curriculum GU Trauma team. At the upcoming 2021 AUA Annual Meeting in Las Vegas, he will be one of nine urologists honored as the 2021 AUA Young Urologists of the Year.
